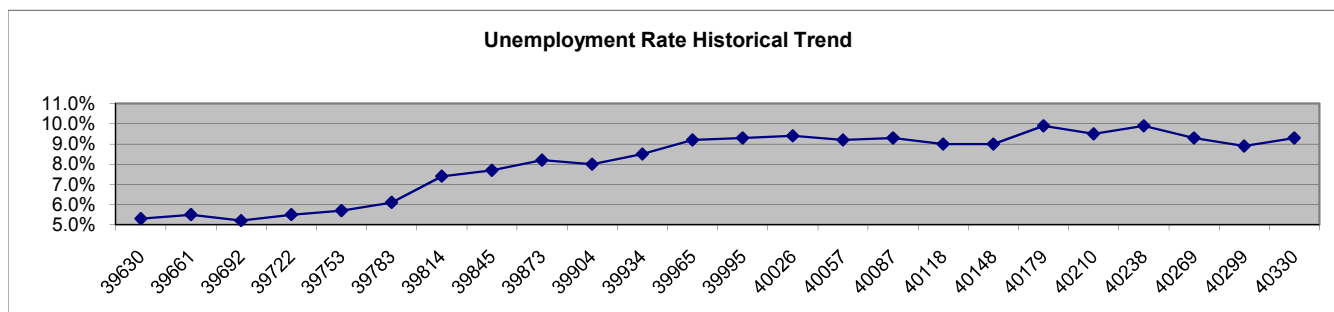


Labor Market Information

The unemployment rate in the San Francisco-San Mateo-Redwood City MD was 9.3 percent in June 2010, up from a revised 8.9 percent in May 2010, and above the year-ago estimate of 9.2 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 12.2 percent for California and 9.6 percent for the nation during the same
