



The San Francisco Center for Economic Development (SF CED) and the San Francisco Chamber of Commerce have planned a business-focused trip to Shanghai and Beijing to coincide with the World Expo in June 2010.

The itinerary has been assembled to provide maximum opportunities to meet with business and government officials, as well as to be in Shanghai during San Francisco Week at the World Expo. While the business portion of the agenda is still in progress, here are the important highlights:

Dates: June 14, 2010 – June 25, 2010

10 Nights/11 Days (Shanghai/Beijing, with 3 days of tickets to World Expo)

Includes most meals; local English-speaking guide, coach and Expo tickets for three days.
Domestic economy air travel between Shanghai and Beijing is included.**

Note, a portion of the visit to Shanghai coincides with San Francisco week and the Shanghai Sister City trip to the World Expo. As the Sister City itinerary finalizes, there will be opportunities to participate in some of the activities at favorable rates.

Hotel: 4-Star hotels in both cities; Doubletree by Hilton Beijing and Sofitel Grand Mercure Baolong Hotel, Shanghai.

Air: Delegation members are responsible for their own international air tickets (San Francisco – Shanghai; Beijing – San Francisco).
